

General Spring Cleaning - most likely these will show up in nearly every room:

Open all the windows

Windows/windowsills - clean inside and out

Wood furniture

Clean & polish, wax if needed

Floors

Remove area rugs, move furniture if possible

Vacuum thoroughly

Mop with an antibacterial cleaner or diluted ammonia

Tile Surfaces

Sweep and mop, use grout cleaner if needed

Carpets

Steam clean (not just heavy traffic areas)

Area rugs

Clean according to labels

Upholstered furnishings

Vacuum entire surface and under cushions

Spot clean fabric as needed

Dust

Ceiling fans

Above cabinets

Baseboards

Doorways

Books/shelves

Lampshades

Walls

Doorjams/Doors

Light switches

Public Areas - specific to certain rooms:

Kitchen:

Dishwasher

Run empty with a dishwasher cleaner

Counters

Lime deposits around faucets

Clean & seal granite

Cabinets

Thoroughly clean cabinet doors and knobs

Pantry

Organize (pull everything out and put back)

Toss expired food

Stove

Clean under knobs

Drip pans

Vent

Oven (self-cleaning if you can)

Refrigerator

Empty and toss expired foods

Clean entire interior

Wipe all exterior surfaces included top

Clean seals around doors with toothbrush

Pull fridge out and sweep and mop floor underneath

Change water filter on ice maker

Living Room/Family Room/Dining Room:

Drapes

take them down, remove hooks and run them through an air-fluff cycle in the dryer with a damp towel (to attract the dust) for 15 minutes. Re-hang immediately.

Fireplace (Consider having professionally cleaned)
